
How is the retreat set up?

Each retreat is built upon the *Spiritual Exercises* of Saint Ignatius of Loyola. Silence, common and personal prayer, Biblical contemplation, celebration of the Eucharist and personal spiritual direction structure the days and create time and space to listen to God and your inner voice. A Jesuit father from either Stockholm or Uppsala will be your spiritual director.

Practicalities

Meals will be arranged by way of self-catering in the group. The cost for each retreat weekend is around SEK 500, but exact amount will be given at registration. Journeys to Gotland will normally be paid for and organized by each participant. If costs for travel is an issue, and needs support, please contact the retreat leader for exploring possibility of co-funding.

The place

The Jesuits in Sweden offer a venue in Visby, Gotland, at the parish house of the Catholic parish in Visby's Old town, for retreats with smaller groups of people during three full days.

Visby is a suitable geographical context, as a calm and small city at the edge of an ocean with many visible signs of its Catholic foundations. You easily find both old and modern areas. The present Catholic parish church and estate give good opportunities for silence in prayer and meditation. From there, gardens, medieval churches, the seaside, the Gotland wilderness and the life of the city are easily accessible.
