In Amsterdam the Community has its center at Waterlooplein, at the Mozes and Aaron Church (in Dutch: Mozes en Aäronkerk). The Community was founded in 1968 in Rome. It takes its name from the church of Sant'Egidio in the neighborhood of Trastevere, where the center of the Community is located.
